simultaneously by linking utopian studies and affect studies grattan s work resists the tendency for affect studies to codify around the negative instead reorienting the field around the messy rich vibrant and ambivalent affective possibilities of the world hope isn t stupid insists on the centrality of utopia not only in american literature but in american life as well
